

#### Infrastructure:

- Lockheed Martin India Private Limited funded Riglam School with INR 11,59,050/- for the construction of computer lab cum Library block for which 70% work done/ proof of fund utilization certificate was sent to the funder.
- From the fund received from the 'Fund Raising Day', We have upgraded our infrastructure facilities and repaired this year under the guidance and support from the SMC members. Currently, the most needed shading for the veranda was completed, where major school's activity performed and where students eat their lunch, now we have much better wall fencing behind the Infant section areas, a notifying school's gate sign board with lighting system at the entrance of the school was furnished.

Many milestones have been achieved in such a short period of time which all happened because of the enthusiastic team work of our SMC members and many still have to be reached.

# **Fund Raising Event:**

The most successful Event of the year was organised by the Education Committee of the Ladakh Buddhist Association (LBA), on 14<sup>th</sup> November 2022, to raise the fund for both the LBA run school; Riglam and Khaltse Jamyang school.
